

Run with the flock at the Turkey Trot 5K Run/Walk! Race begins at 8 a.m.

RACE CATEGORIES

Participants are divided into four groups with staggered starting lines.

RED ZONE

Elite: For runners who have completed a timed 5K race in the last 18 months in less than 21 minutes/men and 24 minutes/women. No dogs or strollers allowed. Elite category starts first.

GREEN ZONE

Runner: For runners who will run the entire race without walking breaks. No dogs or strollers allowed. The Runner category starts second, just after Elite.

WHITE ZONE

Walker/Family/Group/Stroller: For anyone participating with a group, small children or a stroller. Participants may run or walk. No dogs. This category starts third, just after Runner.

YELLOW ZONE

Pet: For anyone participating with a dog. All dogs must be on a leash. (No dogs in Elite or Runner categories.) Participants may run or walk. Strollers, families and groups are allowed. Please clean up after your dog. Pet category starts last.
