

6 Signs – Metal Sign – Black on White – Color Logo

For Your Safety on the Diving Boards

1. To use the diving board, swimmers must be able to swim one length of the pool.
2. Only one person on the board at a time.
3. Divers must go straight off the board.
4. After entering the water, swim to the ladder or out and under the rope.
5. The next diver off the board is not allowed to dive until the first diver has touched the ladder or passed under the rope.
6. *Only one bounce on the board.*
7. Swimming in the diving area is not allowed.

For Your Safety and Information

1. WALK, WALK, WALK!
2. Parents, please watch your children.
3. Diving is allowed off the diving boards only.
4. No breath-holding or prolonged underwater swimming.
5. Do not push, dunk or fight with other guests.

Wading Pool Rules

1. Children 6 and under only.
2. All children must be accompanied by an adult.
3. No running, pushing, riding on backs, or general rough housing.
4. The staff reserves the right to enforce all regulations to maintain a safe atmosphere.

For Your Safety on the Water Slide

1. Guests should be in good health to ride this ride. Guests with heart or back condition or who are pregnant are advised not to ride this ride.
2. Guests that are less than 3 ½ feet tall must pass a swim test before they ride and they must be able to ride alone. **Parents cannot ride with their children at the same time**
3. All guests must ride feet first lying on their back.
4. Only one rider at a time.
5. Arms and hands must remain inside the flume.
6. Only two guests on the steps at any one time.
7. Mats or tubes are not to be used on this slide.
8. Please leave the splash area immediately.
9. No jumping or swimming into the splash area.

General Pool Rules

1. Children 8 and under must be accompanied by an adult.
2. A person with a skin rash or who is under the influence of alcohol or drugs is not allowed to enter the facility.
3. Glass containers & alcoholic beverages are not allowed in this facility
4. No weapons are allowed in this facility.
5. All swimmers must wear a swimsuit into the water.
6. T-shirts may be worn in the pool. They must be clean, not cut off or torn, and cannot have rude language or symbols. If you choose to wear a T-shirt into the water you must stay in the shallow end of the pool only.
7. Radios with batteries only and at low volume.
8. Large inflatable rafts and other items are prohibited unless expressly permitted by the Supervisor on Duty.
9. We reserve the right to have any item removed from the pool for the safety of our other guests.
10. Life jackets and water wings may be used with parental supervision.

11. Only swimmers 6 and younger are allowed in the wading pool. Parental supervision is required.
12. There will be a pool check at 5 minutes before each hour. Ages 18 and up may continue to swim, but all other guests must sit on the side during pool check.
13. The pool may close early due to lack of attendance or severe weather conditions.
14. Not responsible for lost or stolen items.
15. Lawn chairs may be use in designated areas.
16. Use coin-operated lockers at your own risk. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items. There is a \$5 fee for lost locker keys.
17. Please place your gum in the trash before you enter the pool.

Diving Board Rules

1. To use the diving board, swimmers must be able to swim one length of the pool.
2. Cartwheels, handstands, inwards, reverses and seat drops are unsafe and will not be allowed.
3. Parents that are supervising their child's dive may sit on the side of the pool in the diving area.
4. Please do not hang or sit on the rope – it will break!
5. The Pool Supervisor has the right to prohibit any dive that seems too dangerous to perform.

Water Slide Rules

1. Guests should be in good health to ride this ride. Guests with heart or back condition or who are pregnant are advised not to ride this ride.
2. Only one rider at a time.
3. Guests that are less than 3 ½ feet tall must pass a swim test before they ride and they must be able to ride alone. **Parents cannot ride with their children at the same time**
4. No jewelry please.
5. All guests must wear swimsuits on this ride. Guests wearing swimwear with rivets, buckles or zippers will not be allowed to ride the slide.
6. These rules are for the safety of our guests. Failure to follow these rules could result in serious injury to yourself or to others. Please help us operate a safe pool.
