<b>Chesterfield Family Center &amp; Park</b> 2511 W. Republic Road • 417-891-1616												40-acre park includes walking trail and playground. Day passes available for Family Center and indoor aquatics center.
<b>Cooper Tennis Complex &amp; Park</b> 2331 E. Pythian St. • 417-837-5800												Tennis complex includes 12 indoor and 16 outdoor tennis courts and pro shop. Day passes available. Park features soccer and baseball fields and an universal playground.
<b>Cruse Dog Park</b> 2100 W. Catalpa St. • 417-864-1049												Six-acre off-leash dog park, areas for large and small dogs. Day passes available with advance registration. Proof of shots, etc. required.
<b>Dan Kinney Family Center &amp; Park</b> 2701 S. Blackman Road • 417-864-1049												Features universal playground and Miracle League Ball Field. Day passes available to Family Center.
<b>Dickerson Park Zoo</b> 1401 W. Norton Road • 417-864-1800												AZA-accredited 70-acre zoo features 150 species, including elephants, giraffes, big cats, primates, wolves, reptiles. Miniature train rides (seasonal).
<b>Doling Family Center &amp; Park</b> 310 E. Talmage St. • 417-837-5900												56-acre historic park, home of Doling History Museum (open April-October), Giboney Cave. Day passes available to Family Center and indoor aquatics. Park has horseshoes and bocce courts.
<b>Ewing Sports Complex</b> 1400 S. Scenic Ave. • 417-864-1049												86-acre sports complex along the Jordan Creek Greenway featuring five ball fields, a BMX track, drinking fountains, grills, playground and restrooms.
<b>Fassnacht Park &amp; Pool</b> 1300 S. Campbell Ave. • 417-864-1049												Historic outdoor pool, fieldstone pavilion and bridges along Fassnacht Creek. Handball court. Near Springfield Skate Park.
<b>Founders Park</b> 330 E. Water St. • 417-864-1049												Springfield history in photos at the city's founding site, designed to resemble a quarry. Summer outdoor movies and concerts.
<b>Grant Beach Park &amp; Pool</b> 1300 N. Grant Ave. • 417-864-1049												Historic outdoor pool and fieldstone pavilion, home of the Railroad Historical Museum.
<b>Gray/Campbell Farmstead at Nathanael Greene/Close Memorial Park</b> 2400 S. Scenic Ave. • 417-891-1515												Includes the oldest cabin in Springfield, historic barn, grainery, kitchen and Liberty one-room schoolhouse.
<b>Jenny Lincoln Park</b> 300 E. Harrison St. • 417-864-1049												Nine-acre park in downtown Springfield featuring a universal playground, grills and horseshoes. Home to the SPARC School-Park Program.
<b>Jordan Valley Ice Park</b> 635 E. Trafficway St. • 417-866-7444												Two indoor NHL-size ice rinks for ice skating, figure skating, hockey. Pro shop. Open skating available. Home to Missouri State Ice Bears.
<b>Jordan Valley Park</b> 635 E. Trafficway St. • 417-864-1049												Ozarks Stream and Fountain, unique play features, outdoor amphitheater. Connects to Jordan Creek Greenway. Adjoins Jordan Valley Ice Park, Creamery Arts Center, Hammons Field and Sculpture Walk.
<b>Killian Sports Complex &amp; Softball Stadium</b> 2141 E. Pythian St. • 417-837-5817												Six lighted softball fields, including stadium, home to Springfield Softball Hall of Fame Museum and Missouri State Softball.
<b>Lake Country Soccer</b> 2334 E. Pythian St. • 417-862-3211												Eighteen outdoor, two indoor soccer fields, adjacent to Cooper Park.
<b>Lake Springfield Park and Boathouse</b> 5324 S. Kissick Ave. • 417-891-1550												153 scenic acres on Lake Springfield. Rent canoes, paddleboards and kayaks at the boathouse (seasonal). Extensive trails, good fishing and excellent bird watching.
<b>Living Memorial Park</b> 4323 S Nature Center Way • 417-864-1049												10-acre park including an amphitheater, walking trail, grills, pavilion and restrooms.
<b>Lost Hill Park</b> 4705 N Farm Road 151 • 417-864-1049												A 60-acre natural resource area just north of Springfield along the South Dry Sac River, with unique geological features. Connects to Fulbright Spring Greenway.
<b>McDaniel Park</b> 2405 S. National Ave. • 417-864-1049												16-acre park with trailhead access to South Creek Greenway.
<b>Meador Sports Complex, Park &amp; Pool</b> 2500 S. Fremont Ave. • 417-864-1049												Five lighted softball fields, one lighted baseball field, pickleball and tennis courts next to Battlefield Mall. Outdoor pool open seasonally. New universal playground.
<b>Mizumoto Japanese Stroll Garden at Nathanael Greene/Close Memorial Park</b> 2400 S. Scenic Ave. • 417-891-1515												Seven acres of traditional Japanese landscaping, streams, lake, moon bridge, teahouse and new playground. Open April-October.
<b>Nichols Park</b> 1900 W. Nichols St. • 417-864-1049												Home to Springfield's largest and universal playground, newly upgraded in 2018, pickleball courts, paved trail, ball field and tennis courts.
<b>Oak Grove Community Center &amp; Park</b> 1538 S. Oak Grove Ave. • 417-891-1635												Features a nine-hole disc golf course.
<b>Ozark Greenways Trail Network</b> 417-864-2015												70+ miles of recreational/ADA accessible trails in Springfield, Greene County and beyond. Maps at ozarkgreenways.org.
<b>Phelps Grove Park</b> 950 E. Bennett St. • 417-864-1049												Historic center-city park features fieldstone bridges, pavilion and children's wading pool, mature trees, WaterWise Garden, next to Springfield Art Museum and Perry Tennis Courts.
<b>Ritter Springs Park</b> 3683 W. Farm Road 92 • 417-864-1049												246 acres in a rural setting features playground, trails, lake and natural areas. Next to Sac River Mountain Bike Trail. Connects to Fulbright Spring Greenway.
<b>Rutledge-Wilson Farm Park</b> 3825 W. Farm Road 146 • 417-837-5949												Visit cows, miniature horses, pigs and fowl on 207 acres of farmland. Includes barns, gardens, fishing pond, gift shop and farm-themed playground. On Wilson's Creek Greenway.
<b>Sanford Park</b> 3114 S. Franklin Ave. • 417-864-1049												11-park featuring a playground and walking trail. Picnic shelter coming summer 2019.
<b>Sequiota Park</b> 3500 S. Lone Pine Ave. • 417-864-1049												Historic park includes trails, pond and caves at former fish hatchery on Galloway Creek Greenway.
<b>Silver Springs Park &amp; Pool</b> 1100 N. Hampton Ave. • 417-864-1049												Historic park with outdoor pool, tennis courts, basketball courts, a baseball field, horseshoes, picnic tables and grills. Home to Timmons Hall.
<b>Springfield Archery Complex at the Davis Property</b> 5780 S. Farm Rd. 141 • 417-864-1049												Includes an indoor range (20 yards), outdoor sight-in range (70 yards) and a walking wooded 14-target range. All skill levels. Equipment rentals available for \$3.
<b>Springfield Botanical Gardens at Nathanael Greene/Close Memorial Park</b> 2400 S. Scenic Ave. • 417-891-1515												113 acres include the Botanical Center, dozens of botanical gardens and collections, the Dr. Bill Roston Butterfly House (seasonal), trails and playgrounds. Connects to South Creek Greenway.
<b>Springfield Skate Park</b> 945 W. Meadowmere St. • 417-868-8758												Best skate park in the Midwest. Indoor and outdoor course, board rentals, pro shop for skateboards, scooters and BMX bikes.
<b>Tom Watkins Park &amp; Community Center</b> 2100 W. High St. • 417-864-1049												Park features an universal playground, disc golf course, grills, paved trail, basketball and tennis courts and restrooms. Community Center includes tables, chairs and small kitchen.
<b>Valley Water Mill Equestrian Center</b> 4007 N. Farm Road 171 • 417-833-3291												Offers open riding, lessons and birthday parties.
<b>Valley Water Mill Park</b> 2300 E. Valley Water Mill Rd. • 417-864-1049												70 acres of fishing, hiking trails and water education at the Watershed Center along beautiful Valley Water Mill Lake.
<b>Westport Park &amp; Pool</b> 3100 W. Mt. Vernon St. • 417-864-1049												Park features playground, open shelters, tennis and basketball courts, ball field, seasonal pool, picnic tables, drinking fountains, grill and restrooms
<b>Washington Park</b> 1600 N. Summit Ave. • 417-864-1049												Historic park founded in 1869 near Commercial Street with a beautiful large gazebo.
