Field

The Betty and Bobby Allison Miracle League Ball Field is a specially equipped, custom designed field with a cushioned synthetic turf that allows players utilizing wheelchairs and walkers to glide unrestricted without fear of injury. This is a level playing field where players with disabilities can hit, run, catch and play ball.

Rules

Every player bats once each inning.
All players are safe on the bases.
Every player scores a run before the inning is over.
Volunteers serve as "buddies" to assist the players.
Each team and each player wins every game.

Players

Anyone age 5 and up with a disability is welcome to participate in The Miracle League. The specialized field eliminates barriers and allows participation by all.
