### Grades: Preschool-Kindergarten

**30-min. program**

Students will enjoy an animal themed book followed by a visit featuring the animal in the story.

- **March:** "The Perfect Nest"
- **April:** "The Great Sheep Shenanigans"
- **May:** "The Smallest Horse"

### Grades: K-1<sup>st</sup> | PEN PALS

**30-min. program**

Find out what animals live on the farm and why people and animals depend on each other for food and shelter.

### Grades 1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup> | GROWING PAINS

**30-min. program**

Students will learn all about the animal life cycle as they discover how chickens mature from eggs to adults.

### Grades 2<sup>nd</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> | HOOVES & SEEDS

**30-min. program**

How are plants and animals cared for? Students will explore how plants and animals are unique and important to us in their own way.

*Meets science GLE from strands 3; 1A, 1D, 1E and 4; 1A*

### Grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> | FROM FARM TO TABLE

**30-min. program**

Students will learn firsthand just how much goes into a meal and gain appreciation for the role of farms in everyday lives.

*Meets Science GLE from strands 3; 1A, 1B*

### Grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> | READY, SET, GROW

**30-min. program**

Discover the role of plants on a farm and in our lives. Students will learn about the life cycle of a plant and explore the structure and function of plant parts. • *Meets Science GLE from strands 3; 1A, 1B and 4; 1A*
