PICK UP/DROP OFF PROCEDURES

Stay home if...

- You are **feeling sick**
- You have a **sick family member** at home



Directors will meet you outside the doors for Drop off and Pick up of your child.



You will be asked the following questions upon arrival: **Child's temperature, any coughing or shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell, out of state or country in the last 14 days.**



Upon entering the building children will visit a hand washing/sanitizing station. Please review proper hand hygiene with your child before arriving at camp.

TRAVEL POLICY

Personal travel that includes any activity listed below, regardless of location, will likely result in a 14-day quarantine based on parameters provided by the Springfield-Greene County Health Department:

- Participation in any activity, regardless of location, not allowed by the City's Civil Emergency
- Travel to a state, county or community with an active Stay at Home Order
- Transportation by air, train or bus
- Cruise vacation.

REMINDERS FOR SUCCESS

- Rutledge-Wilson follows all CDC guidelines and all recommendations by the Springfield-Greene County Health Department.
- All participants and staff are encouraged to but not required to wear a mask.
- Please have a conversation with your child about the importance of social distancing and keeping hands off their friends and all belongings to themselves.
- Your child will need to bring a lunch each day and it is important to not share food with their friends.
- Campers will be asked to follow proper hand washing procedures several times throughout each day. Common surfaces will be cleaned and disinfected each hour.
- Water fountains will be closed. Campers are encouraged to bring water bottles from home, and we will have disposable cups available.
