Grades: PreK-K | BOOK IN THE BARN

30-min. program

Students will love the story reading of Pumpkin Soup followed by an animal interaction in the classroom.

Grades: K-2nd | PUMPKIN TIME

30-min. program

Encourages students to explore how pumpkins grow. During this program students will learn all about a pumpkins lifecycle.
